Re: Arthur and ors v Layte

I acknowledge receipt of your papers, which this office received on 24 November 2009.

Your papers were referred to a Master of Civil Appeals who has asked me to inform you of the following:

"The order of His Honour Judge Griggs dated 30 October does not appear to represent a 'final decision' on a multi track Part 7 Claim in the sense of the Destination of Appeals Order 2000. It appears to be a case management decision or decision determining, at least, some form of matter ancillary to the detailed assessment of costs which, pursuant to CPR PD 52 para 2A.4(2), as appealed from a Circuit Judge to a High Court Judge at the local District Registry. The better course might be for the defendants to seek an oral hearing before Judge Griggs."

Accordingly, I return your papers. I will arrange a £200 refund which you will receive shortly.
